The NYC Justice Corps brings young adults together with their communities to identify and address unmet community needs.

The NYC Justice Corps is a six-month job readiness program providing its members with the opportunity to contribute to the betterment of their communities while building skills necessary to become quality employees. The NYC Justice Corps seeks to identify **Employer Partners** to provide internship and job opportunities to Corps members who are ready to enter the workforce.

MOTIVATED AND PREPARED TEAM PLAYERS

NYC Justice Corps members receive quality training and services that prepare them for the workplace:

- *Work readiness including time management and computer skills*
- *Teamwork, communication and workplace conduct*
- *Hands-on experience and collaboration with community leaders in helping to improve their local communities*
- *Job search and interview skills*
- *Support to ensure they stay employed and continue to develop professionally*

The result is **qualified, motivated candidates** who can fill a range of entry-level positions.

HOST A CORPS INTERN

Each Corps member participates in a 6-8 week internship for up to 28 hours per week. Interns are matched with available opportunities based on interests and level of skill, and the NYC Justice Corps provides an hourly stipend at no cost to Employer Partners. At the end of the internship period, a host company may opt to offer a permanent position.

HIRE A CORPS GRADUATE

NYC Justice Corps graduates are groomed to be leaders and effective team players. By the end of their six-month enrollment, they have gained the skills and confidence to help them successfully transition to full employment and become valuable staff members. NYC Justice Corps provides ongoing support during the first six months of employment.

BENEFITS OF BEING AN EMPLOYER PARTNER

Our staff works with each Employer Partner to provide:

- *Assessment of employer needs*
- *Pre-screened applicants*
- *Interview scheduling*
- *Ongoing referral and placement services*
- *Post-placement support for Corps members*
- *Support to supervisors of Corps member interns/employees*

Employer Partners may also be eligible for financial incentives.
